

## Waste Reduction and Recycling Plan 2019-2022 Information Sheet

The community is invited to review and comment on the Lockyer Valley Regional Council's draft *Waste Reduction and Recycling Plan 2019-2022* (WRRP) between Wednesday 6 March and Monday 8 April 2019.

It is a statutory obligation for Council to have such a (WRRP) Plan under the provisions of the *Waste Reduction and Recycling Act 2011*. The draft Plan sets a clear pathway for the management of solid waste in the Lockyer Valley region towards and beyond 2022.

Highlighted below are several of the key areas that Council is seeking feedback from the community including references to relevant sections within the draft Plan.

Please note that there are no changes proposed to the operational hours of the Gatton and Laidley waste facilities or the rural bins during the life of this Plan.

### **1.0 Proposed Closure of the Helidon Waste Facility**

Council proposes to close the Helidon waste facility from 1 July 2019 due to low usage and the proximity of other waste facilities. Refer to the following sections of the draft Plan for additional information:

### **2.0 Establishment of a Proposed Waste Facility at the Otto Road (Glenore Grove) Quarry Site**
