

Lockyer Valley Skatepark Data 2019

<u>Brief</u>

A recent survey across the Lockyer Valley region was undertaken to better help understand future planning of skateparks in the region. Overall consult is based on 3 documents.

- 1. Surveying community
- 2. Scoping sites and listing existing infrastructure
- 3. Maintenance and condition report.

With these 3 pieces of information LVRC will be able to compile a strategy and plan around future skateparks upgrades and maintenance.

'Helidon skatepark needs a major upgrade. It's the only place for kids to go in the area? It desperately needs shade and water at a minimum. The park needs expansion. Give the kids somewhere decent to hang out'

'Paths updates on the concrete'

'Please for heavens sake get rid of the bitumen'

ANALYSIS

General guideline of park users.

The average skatepark user in LVRC region is male between 14 and 23 years old, and majority ride scooter or skateboards.

Majority of users will use at least 3 of the skateparks and 75% of these people use the skatepark at least 1 day on a weekly basis.

Majority of these drive or have parents drive them to facilities.

93% of these people would drive or travel to a major regional facility.

Forest Hill, Gatton and Laidley are the top skateparks of choice in the region, outweighing their counterparts significantly.

Roughly 40% of skatepark users come from Gatton and Laidley, with the other 60% coming from all the other towns.

Guideline on Infrastructure

We've determines the most popular obstacles as seen in the pie chart earlier in this report. When looking at Major works it is recommended to pass this information onto the skatepark designers who will be working with Council on the projects.

Shade, Toilets and Lights were the most commonly requested updates at existing parks, followed closely by Water and seating





Final Notes

From this data, we would recommend one regional facility to service that larger demographic, using the most popular obstacles from the region listed. With the other regional parks, Rolling out maintenance, shade, lights, toilets and seating over time seems to be the most common request to allow best use of skateparks. On weekends people can spend up to 8 hours at a skatepark, so these things play in important role in usage.
